Art – please give this work to your Art teacher in September.


TASK: You will draw 3 pictures from your perspective and create your art own piece based on art based on 'Houses by the Sea' by the painter Paul Klee.

- Using a pencil to draw, can you are to capture an area of that room.




- Choose a window in your home that has an interesting view. (The street outside would be lovely!)
